Instruction begins the week of January 3, 2010 and ends the week of March 14, skipping the week of February 14.

Supervised instruction from 1-3 p.m. for the first nine weeks; there is no JISP supervision from 3-4 p.m. The 10th week will be free ski and ride for students and instructors. **There are no makeup days.**

JISP Sunday Schedule

- At Bromley on December 20, January 3, 10, 31; Feb. 7, 21, 28; March 14, 21. **JISP ANNUAL RACE, March 21.** Bromley Sundays start at 11 a.m. All JISPers must show JISP ID to receive a ticket at front main ticket window. Drivers show ID and pay \$15. Instructors use one voucher to receive ticket.
- At Stratton on January 24 and March 7.
Stratton exchange is full day; bring JISP ID for identification to any ticket window to receive complimentary ticket.

Very Important, Please Note

- **NO FREE SKIING IF JISP IS CANCELLED. NO JISP IF SCHOOL IS CANCELLED.**
- JISP ID passes must be worn so visible to lift attendants.
- \$10 replacement fee for lost passes at Bromley customer service
- Skiing/snowboarding drivers and instructors need to join the BOC prior to the start of JISP to receive mountain privileges.

Alpine Ski/Snowboarding Fees:

\$85 per student; \$255 maximum per family. Equipment rentals available from the Bromley Rental Shop; \$75 for season (please note this is a separate payment made to Bromley when renting equipment). Rental fitting and sizing days are Dec. 1 through the 20th, 9:00am to 4:00pm. Please try to get rentals sooner than later. There is a \$75 deposit required for rentals that will be forfeited if equipment is not returned by May 1, 2010.

BROMLEY OUTING CLUB JUNIOR INSTRUCTIONAL SKI/SNOWBOARD PROGRAM

The Bromley Outing Club sponsors the Junior Instructional Ski/Snowboard Program (JISP), benefiting area children. The alpine ski and snowboard programs are made possible through the efforts and cooperation of Bromley Mountain Resort and the school boards of the participating towns. Students in grades **three through twelve** are dismissed early from school one afternoon per week on their school's assigned day and are transported to Bromley Mountain by volunteer car pools. Volunteer instructors under the supervision of the Bromley Outing Club staff carry out instruction. Adult volunteers are always needed for the program to function.

Benefits to volunteers

Drivers: Drive 3 or more Jisp or Kap students and receive a lift ticket for \$10 dollars for your Jisp afternoon, \$15 for Bromley Sundays. Remember, shared drivers, share benefits. All drivers must be BOC members. Don't forget to bring your BOC card for identification.

Instructors: Earn one voucher for each day of teaching-one voucher equals one ticket mid-week and non-holiday Sundays. Two vouchers in exchange for Saturdays and all holiday periods designated by Bromley Mountain. Two free Stratton days. Free skiing from 11:30am until 1pm and after your class on the day you teach. You need to use a voucher to ski on Bromley JISP Sundays. You must commit to ten weeks of instruction; join the BOC; attend preseason clinic; sign in and pick up your attendance card. Instructors are responsible for finding their own substitutes. Previous years credits are good until 12/18/09.

Special Needs Program: Bromley Mountain's Bart Center offers individualized ski/snowboard instruction to students who are challenged with physical or emotional needs. Please contact Joe Hurley, Bart Center Director, at 824.5522 ext 430 or at 447.1054.

BOC racing-snowboard-freestyle program participants: Members must sign and return JISP Form but do not pay JISP fees.

Conduct: All JISP participants must take instruction each week. They are expected to conduct themselves properly and safely at all times while on the mountain property. The JISP staff reserves the right to suspend any student from the program for misconduct.

The BOC office is located at Bromley Mountain, east of the main lodge at the base of the East Meadow. JISPs are always welcome to go there for assistance or emergency telephone use.
